What is



FERPA is a federal privacy law that affords parents the right to:

- have access to their children's education records,
- seek to have the records amended, and

 consent to the disclosure of personally identifiable information (PII) from education records, except as provided by law.

When does

FERPA

apply?





Education records are records that are: 1. directly related to a student; and 2. maintained by an educational agency or institution or by a party acting for the agency or institution.

Mini-Lesson


Health records on students, including immunization records, maintained by an educational agency or institution subject to FERPA are "educational records".



Videos must be directly related. Resulted in disciplinary action • Shows a violation of the law Shows an occurrence of student injury, attack, illness, or health emergency Audio or visual record contains content that includes PII for a student's educational record

Videos are **NOT education records** when...

Students are in the background
Photos or videos do not focus on a specific student

• Content is maintained by law enforcement (If a copy is provided to the school, that copy may become an education record.)

When videos are **directly** related & involve multiple students... Parents' FERPA rights apply • Redaction is required when reasonable & does not destroy the meaning of the video Schools cannot charge for redaction Copies are allowed (not required)

scenario 1

A police officer shows up at the main office of a middle school, and asks to view video surveillance of an active student. The police officer suspects this student is involved in gang violence that occurred three weeks ago. The police officer does not have a court order. Can the school allow the officer to view the video footage?

Mini-Lesson



When a student turns 18 years old, or attends a postsecondary institution at any age they become an "eligible student" and, the rights under FERPA transfer from the parents to them.

scenario 2

Lucy is a 17 year old high school student at your school and is enrolled in the career and technical education Culinary Arts Program. The Culinary Arts Program has an articulation agreement with the local community college. As such, Lucy is dually-enrolled at the community college where she is taking the Artisan Breads & Pastries class. Lucy's parents have requested a copy of Lucy's education records maintained at both your school and the community college. What information can you provide the parents?

Mini-Lesson



Under FERPA, "parent" means a parent of a student and includes a natural parent, a guardian, Or an individual acting as a parent in the absence of a parent or guardian. includes custodial 🖧 noncustodial parents

FERPA affords full rights to a parent, unless the school has been provided with evidence that there is a court order or state law that specifically revokes these rights.

Rights

FERPA rights of parents include...

- Right to inspect and review education records;
- Right to request amendment of education records;
- Right to consent to disclosure, with certain exceptions; and
- Right to file a complaint with U.S. Department of Education regarding an alleged violation of FERPA.

scenario 3

Jack and Diane, two young people from a small town in Arkansas, fall in love and get married. After 10 years, and two kids, they grow apart and get divorced. Jack moves to California and Diane stays in her small town. Diane gets remarried and has sole custody of the kids.

Concerned about how his children are doing, Jack asks the school for access to his children's education records. Knowing that he doesn't live with his children, the school denies the request. Did the school do the right thing?

Mini-Lesson



Under the "school official exception", schools may disclose PII from education records without consent if the disclosure is to other school officials within the school who the school has determined to have legitimate educational interest. (Annual notification of FERPA rights must include criteria for determining who constitutes a school official and what constitutes a legitimate educational interest.)

What is directory information?

Directory information includes information in a student's education record that would not generally be considered harmful or an invasion of privacy if disclosed.



Directory information may include...

- name, address, phone number, and e-mail address
- photograph
- date and place of birth
- most recent school attended
- grade level & major field of study
- participation in officially recognized sports & activities
- height & weight of athletes
- degrees, honors, and awards received

Directory information



- include Social Security Number (SSN)
- disclose non-directory information with directory information

Directory information requires...

- Annual notice must be given to parents of students in attendance and eligible students in attendance.
- Parents may choose to "opt-out" of the disclosure of directory information for their child.

scenario 4

A community-based organization that has programs for children with special needs approaches you regarding their programs. They have requested the name, address, and telephone number of parents with students in your school who have a disability to offer their services. You like the programs offered by the organization and believe the programs may be of benefit to the students with disabilities and their parents. Can the names and contact information for these students be disclosed to the organization?
